## *The Musical Genius Hotel's Mozart Suite*



### *Why stay in the Mozart suite?*

Created in honour of child prodigy and composer, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart (1756–1791), the suite features symbols of the high times he had with his friends and family during his often difficult, rollercoaster life.

- a set of finely crafted classical instruments, including a piano and violin
- a dance floor and music system programmed with a range of Mozart's 600+ works
- a large billiard room with a wet bar stocked with Italian wine and Austrian beer
- a closet full of elegant clothing and costumes from Mozart's days in the limelight



### *Did you know...?*

Mozart could hear a piece of music one time, and from memory write the entire artistic work on paper.

### *More about Mozart*

- was first taught music, languages and academics by his father
- started composing music at age 5 and was often invited to travel to Italy and other places to perform in front of royalty
- had money problems his whole life, partly because of low pay for musicians, despite Mozart's obvious genius – but when times were good, Mozart lived a lavish and excessive lifestyle with his wife and children
